#### Scope:

Production of the CSD Series of Solid State Relays is being discontinued. The CSD family can be replaced by the fully compatible CSW Series of Solid State Relays.

## Last Time Buy Date:

Thursday December 1<sup>st</sup> 2015. These items have been granted a 4 month last time buy period. The products will become obsolete on Monday January 4<sup>th</sup> 2016.

## Alternative Products/Models:

The CSD Series is being totally replaced by the CSW Series which has the same or better electrical performance, ratings and features. The CSW Series is part of our Generation 4 line of







SSRs, which have some significant improvements with regards to the Generation 3 SSRs. A comparison between these 2 Series is shown below:












## F option (Faston Terminals):









The following are some of the changes done on the Gen 4 SSRs that apply to the CSW series:

- 1. The CSW series feature new SEMs screw washers with higher wire pull out specs and include plastic anti rotation barriers.
- 2. Epoxy free construction which reduces the product weight.
- 3. Direct copper output leads design which reduces power losses and increase reliability.
- 4. The Generation 4 design utilizes an optical Triac coupler for input/output isolation and for triggering the output circuit. This translates into better noise immunity and improved dv/dt capability.
- 5. Due to the improved dv/dt capability the Generation 4 design doesn't require an RC snubber, which reduces the output leakage current.
- 6. Generation 4 SSRs have a standard input current regulation circuit which consumes less power at higher input control voltages.

Also to take into consideration:

- The CSW series accepts the KS101 touch safe cover, which has an improved latching system compared to the old KS100 cover.
- For customers mounting the SSR into a PCB (or a PCB on top of the SSR) they need to order the part number with suffix K, which has hex standoff terminals.
